

# ABI MONTHLY REPORT<sup>1</sup> – April 2026

## (Main evidence)

### BANK LENDING

1. In March 2026, **the stock of loans to households and non-financial corporations increased by 2.4% yoy**, accelerating from +2.2% recorded in February, continuing the growth path that began in March 2025. In detail, **for households it is the fifteenth consecutive month in which there has been an increase and for businesses it is the ninth consecutive month in which loans have grown. In fact, in February 2026 loans to households had grown by 2.6% and those to businesses by 1.8%** (cf. Table 1).

### STOCK OF CUSTOMER FUNDING

2. **Indirect funding**, i.e. investments in securities held by banks (both under management and held directly by customers) **increased by €78.8 billion** between February 2025 and February 2026 (€30.2 billion attributable to households, €15 to non-financial corporations and the remaining to other sectors, financial companies, insurance companies, public administration).
3. In March 2026, **total funding** (deposits from resident customers and bonds) **increased by 2.6% yoy** continuing the positive trend observed since the beginning of 2024 (+3.8% in the previous month; cf. *Table 2*).
4. In March 2026 **deposits**, in their various forms, **increased by 2.7% yoy** (+4.3% in the previous month).
5. **Medium and long-term funding**, i.e. through bonds, in March 2026 **increased by 1.5%** compared to a year earlier (+0.6% in the previous month).

## LENDING INTEREST RATES

### 6. In March 2026:

- **the average rate on total outstanding loans** (i.e., those agreed upon over the years) was **3.98%** (as in the previous month);
- **the average rate on new business loans** decreased to **3.26%** (3.33% in the previous month and 5.45% in December 2023);
- **the average rate on new loans for house purchasing** decreased to **3.36%** (3.44% in the previous month; 4.42% in December 2023; cf. Table 3).

## INTEREST RATES ON BANKING FUNDING

7. The **interest rate on new deposits with agreed maturity** (i.e. certificates of deposit and time deposits) in March 2026 was **2.09%**, stable compared to the previous month and higher than the euro area average of 1.88% in February. **Compared to June 2022**, when the interest rate was 0.29% (the last month before the start of the official interest rate hikes) **the increase was 180 basis points.**
8. **The yield on new fixed-rate bond issues in March 2026 was 2.88%.**
9. In March 2026, **the interest rate on total amounts of deposits** (current accounts, savings deposits and certificates of deposit), was **0.65%** (up from 0.64% in February 2026 and 0.32% in June 2022).
10. **The interest rate on current accounts**, which does not have the function of investment and allows the use of a multitude of services, in March 2026 **was 0.28%** (up from 0.27% in the previous month; 0.02% in June 2022; cf. Table 4).

## SPREAD BETWEEN LENDING RATE AND FUNDING RATE

11. The **spread on new business** (calculated as the difference between the rates on new loans and new funding) with household and non-financial corporations **in Italy**, in March 2026 was **191 basis points.**

## CREDIT QUALITY

12. **In February 2026, net non-performing loans** (i.e., the total of bad loans, unlikely-to-pay exposures, and past due and/or overdrawn exposures, calculated net of write-downs and provisions already made by the banks) decreased to **€27.6 billion** from €30 billion in September 2025 (€31.3 billion in December 2024). Compared to their peak level of €196.3 billion reached in 2015, they have decreased by almost €169 billion.
13. **In February 2026, net non-performing loans represented 1.32% of total loans.** This ratio was lower than in September 2025 (1.43%; 1.51% in December 2024; 9.8% in December 2015; *cf. Table 5*).
